### Sukhna Lake

Sukhna Lake in Chandigarh

is man-made, created by damming the seasonal stream that comes down from the Shivalik Hills, Sukhna Choe. Le Corbusier's greatest creation, his vision for Sukhna lake still lives on. Carrying on his legacy, till date no motor boats are allowed in the lake and

neither are any motor vehicles on the promenade. Le Corbusier had predicted that people would be drawn to Sukhna Lake for the care of their body and spirit. True to his words, even before the sun dawns over the lake and well after it sets, people of all ages can be seen walking, jogging, sprinting on the promenade, outlining the lake's perimeter. Distances of 500 meter, 1 km and so on are marked on the promenade, so you can easily map the distance covered by you. While the lake has fish, but fishing out here is restricted. With migratory birds like Crane, Stork and Siberian Duck having discovered the delights of Sukhna Lake, it has been declared a protected national wetland.

## Rock Garden

A fantasyland created out of industrial waste, rocks and concrete, Rock Garden in Chandigarh is an artistic splendour. A living monument to Picasso's

adage "Everything you can imagine is real",

the breathtaking garden is a place of superlatives. Designed and established on a conserved land, it was the creator and artist Nek Chand's own secret garden that he worked on in his spare time. The thousands of sculptures that stand today in the shape of human beings, birds, monkeys, soldiers, are entirely made of waste material that Nek Chand collected over the years.

#### As you enter

Rock Garden, the path will lead you through a series of maze-like arches, tunnels and bridges, with passages leading into open-air galleries full of sculptures made out of broken glass bangles, ceramic pottery, wires, etc; each even more striking than the one before. At some point, midway through the place, the walls close in and then open out to a stretch of waterfall, with the stream of water leading from it occasionally filled with quacking ducks. Be sure to peer closely at the walls you pass; you will find them to be made of broken plates, sockets, gunny bags, glass bangles- all bound together with cement.

## Cactus Garden

An ecosytem of cacti and succulents, Cactus Garden is a sprawling landscape that has been lovingly created and planted into existence, cactus by cactus. Spread over 7 acres, the vision leading it was to develop a space for the preservation and conservation of endangered species of cacti and succulents. The garden has different varieties of cacti, some flowering in delightful colours.

You will come across a dazzling collection of over 2,500 species of cactus, landscaped by Dr. J.S. Sarkaria. A visit to this garden is really more of a revelation, and you come to see and appreciate cactus in a new way. You will find cacti small enough to fit your palm and some towering at 11-15 ft.

# Zakir Hussain Rose Garden

For those hailing from concrete jungles, Zakir Hussain Rose Garden is the perfect place to head to. Replete with some 1,600 different varieties of roses, the garden is a sight to behold in spring and winter when it's taken over by blossoming flowers and busily buzzing bees and birds. Named after the 3rd President of India, Dr. Zakir Hussain, a pioneering educationist and statesman, the garden was established in 1967.

While roses are the stars here, the garden is replete with other flowers and medicinal plants as well, a

figure totalling around 17,000+ plants. Take a walk through its sculpted landscape and here and there you can spot Bel/Bael trees, Yellow Gulmohar, Camphor, Bahera and Harar/Harad, all medicinal plants of immense significance.

Zakir Hussain Rose Garden is one of Asia's largest rose gardens. Typically, the garden is serene and tranquil where birds belt out melodious songs, but come February, it buzzes with excitement and activity in preparation for the Rose Festival and Annual Festival of Gardens held in March, a major cultural event of Chandigarh.

5 National Gallery of Portraits

The National Gallery of Portraits in Chandigarh is a portrait of India's relentless struggle for independence that spanned over two centuries. Here you will come across photographs of not only people who led the freedom struggle, but also various historic events and incidents. There are duplicates of original writings and documents of the freedom fighters and an incredible collection of books on the freedom movement in its library.

You can also listen to the recorded voices of some of these great leaders, including Mahatma Gandhi and Pandit Jawarhar Lal Nehru. As you listen to the speeches, you can feel the energy of the movement pulsate and run through you across the speakers, warming your heart. Also housed at the gallery are rare documents, photographs, books, ceramic murals and sculptures dating from that time. Every Sunday at 2 PM the gallery features a film on the freedom movement of India.
